Session Information and Costs

A career pathway planning interview

is two and a half hours long and costs \$220. The session commences with a vocational assessment. Then we will discuss your career/ employment / educational situation in relation to your career aspirations, aptitudes and interests; and look at any barriers you may be experiencing. The session concludes with the preparation of a career pathway plan for your future.

Career counselling interviews are one hour long and cost \$90. You may need just one or two sessions to address a specific career challenge or to clarify your pathway. Or you may choose to have ongoing sessions while you manage a career change or life transition.
